Pro tip: If you're moving by car, assemble the survival kit items into an easy-to-reach box and put the more essential items that you may need to carry with you in a small bag. If you're moving by plane, be sure to pack it into a carry on bag. Consider having small children assemble their own miniature "Moving Day Survival Kit" with their favorite snacks, drinks, band-aids, and toys so that they don't clutter up the official moving day survival kit you'll need and so that the children feel like they're making a big contribution to moving by being responsible for something.

Essentials To Include:

- Prescriptions and essential medication
- Cash
- Swiss army knife or pocket knife
- Important documents (social security number, mortgage papers, marriage license, medical records, birth records, etc.)
- Change of clothes for all family members
- Trash bags
- First Aid Kit:
 - Band-aids
 - Ointment
 - Ice/heat packs
 - Ankle wraps
 - Aspirin or other pain killers

- Toiletries:
 - Rolls of toilet paper
 - Hand soap
 - Toothbrush
 - Toothpaste
 - Shampoos
 - Cleaning supplies
 - Towels

 - Phone and phone charger

- Items from the bedroom:
 - Favorite pillow
 - Favorite linens
 - Alarm clock (or phone)
- Items to assemble furniture and move in:

 - Hammer
 - Drill
 - Scissors
 - Masking tape or PVC tape
 - Or portable tool kit
- For children:
 - Favorite toys or games
 - Favorite pajamas
 - Audio books or DVDs
 - Baby changing supplies
 - 2 to 3 books

- Items from the kitchen:
 - 1 cup
 - 1 plate
 - 1 set of utensils
 - 1 bowl
 - Tea, coffee, or other caffeinated beverage
 - Bottled water
 - Favorite snacks
 - Something to eat for breakfast and/or lunch
- For pets:
 - Food
 - Leases and collars
 - Vaccination records
 - Medication pets take
 - Pet's favorite toy
 - Waste essentials (cat litter, doggy pee pads, etc.)
- Power strip
- Notepads
- Pencils/pens
- Flashlight
- Wine/bottle opener
- Worst case scenario:**
 - Something to keep you entertained if you don't have internet for several days
 - Anything you need the next day in the event that the moving truck gets lost and won't arrive for an additional couple days
